These students will need to memorize their parts between our 5/30 workshop and 6/8 camp week start. So we recommend that students signing up for this section of camp be committed to putting in the time outside of camp, in order to bring the show to life. This opportunity is best suited for the musical theatre diehards out there.

Are the performances mandatory?

I recognize that not all theatre lovers like to perform for an audience. If your student wants to attend camp, but does not want to perform in the Friday evening and/or Saturday afternoon performances, just let us know. Especially if they are in the 1st–3rd Theatre Camp, it will not be a problem.

My 4th–9th grade actor is not able to attend the audition date and/or the cast workshop. Will they still get a part?

YES! If your camper is in the 4th–9th Acting Camp and not able to attend the dates prior to the camp week (June 8–13), they will be cast in the ensemble. The ensemble will perform lots of fun numbers like "Under the Sea," "Kiss the Girl" and "Poor Unfortunate Souls." They will get loads of stage time!

How will I order tickets?

We will provide an online ticket sale link to all registered families. Seating will be on the gym floor and bleachers and will be available on a first come, first served basis. Audience members will also be able to purchase tickets at the door.
